Dear Parent/Carer

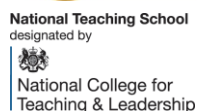
Just one week to go until the long-awaited summer break! I continue to thank you, your children and the staff for their enthusiasm, hard work and understanding in such unprecedented times!

As I explained last week, the government has produced detailed guidance of how we can open safely in September. A full risk assessment has been produced, which will be published on our website once consultation with the staff is concluded. The risk assessment follows the guidance in full and, in some cases, goes beyond the expectations. We believe that the measures being introduced will significantly reduce the risks involved in the reopening of the school. Your child's safety is our number 1 priority!

I have attached our new home-school agreement addendum for you to read carefully with your child. It is essential that everyone plays their part in ensuring that the entire school community is safe. I thank you, in advance, for your co-operation. Please contact your child's pastoral lead if you have any questions about the addendum.

As a reminder, we expect full attendance in September. The government has clearly stated that fines of up to £120 will be issued to parents whose children fail to attend school. Your child simply cannot afford to miss this invaluable time of their education. I also attach a revised data collection form that we ask is completed and returned by email by Friday 17th July to data@painsley.staffs.sch.uk. It is important that we have the correct data so we can contact you if necessary. You will notice that the form also includes a request for your date of birth and National Insurance number. By completing these details, we will be able to regularly check eligibility for Free School Meals and Pupil Premium using the online checking service. We will not use these details for any other purpose.

This Sunday's Gospel recounts the parable of the sower. As a reminder, the seed that falls on the rich soil is like someone who hears what Jesus is asking, understands it, and lives their life as he asks them to. Jesus invites us to turn to Him and ask for His help!
