As we come to the end of what has been a difficult and challenging term, we can look forward to the summer holidays and most importantly to our results days. We have now received the government guidance and can confirm that you will be able to collect your results in person or have them sent via email. Time slots will be staggered throughout the morning for face to face collection. Emails will be sent out shortly after 9.30am. The dates for the results to be published are Thursday 13th August for A levels and Thursday 20th August for GCSE.

In line with the national guidance and in order to maintain your safety, there will be some key restrictions in place. Students who have opted to collect their results in person will be invited to the site in small groups (specific times will be emailed the day before). Students must attend alone and not bring parents or friends onto the school site. You are asked to only arrive on site at your allocated time and to wait in a socially distanced queue outside Sixth Form Main reception. Once you have collected the results you are asked to leave the building via the V block and to exit the college site straight away. Senior staff will be available for students who have any queries or concerns about their future pathways.

Any subject change requests must be made by Monday 24th August.
