Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you for your patience and understanding with the arrangements we have had to make for our summer events. Following the change to the roadmap and advice from the local outbreak team we have made the following alterations to planned activities:

- Year 12 transition days – virtual
- Year 6 transition day – reduced to one day per school/student, so bubbles can be easily maintained
- Year 11 celebration morning has been postponed until Monday 19th July
- Sports day – competitors will come to school in PE kits and compete within year groups. There will be no spectators this year
- Rewards trips will operate for the eligible students in Year 7 and 8. All other eligible students (top 10% in each year) will receive a voucher reward

Other events will only continue where our contingency measures can remain in place. Once again, I ask that all students continue to test twice weekly and record your results with NHS test and trace and on our website.

I am delighted that our DoE Bronze and Silver students are able to take part in their practise expeditions this weekend. Year 10 will be participating in a virtual work experience day and students will be recording a virtual summer concert which will be shared with you in due course. A group of Year 8 students will also have the opportunity to visit Alton Towers to ride the new Gangsta Granny ride and meet senior staff at the park.

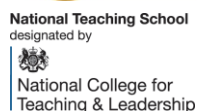
