Dear Parent/Carer

I do hope you have had a restful half-term and have had the opportunity to enjoy some sunshine.

As Year 11 have embarked on the next stage of their learning journey I write with a few key reminders:

- Year 11 official leaving date is Friday 25<sup>th</sup> June. Although most of you will be studying at home, some students will be required in school.
- Students attending our sixth form should return their transition forms. Transition days are either Monday 21<sup>st</sup> or Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> June and Friday 16<sup>th</sup> July. Students will be set transitional work for the duration of the transitional period.
- Students not attending our sixth form should complete the English and maths work set on Show My Homework and engage in transitional activities for their chosen courses.
- The deadline for returning books and locker keys is Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June.
- Year 11 celebration morning is Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June from 8.45am to 12pm.
- GCSE results day is Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> August.

Please be aware there are clear government expectations for students in relation to paid work. These are outlined below and remain in place until the official leaving date of Friday 25<sup>th</sup> June.

Please be mindful that students are not allowed to work;

- For more than 1 hour before school
- For more than 4 hours without taking a break of at least 1 hour
- In any work that may be harmful to their health, wellbeing or education
- Without a 2 week break from any work during the school holidays each calendar year

During term time children can only work a maximum of 12 hours a week. This includes:

- A maximum of 2 hours on school days and Sundays
- A maximum of 8 hours for 15 to 16 year olds

Once again, I thank the Year 11 for all their contributions to school life. I look forward to seeing them all on 30<sup>th</sup> June and many of them at our sixth form transition days.
