- Working closely with KS3/KS4 in practical lessons – training students how to use machinery safely. Keeping a close eye on students whilst using machines during practical lessons, helping KS3 (Years 7 & 8) with patterns and cutting out. KS4 (Years 10 & 11)– working closely with students whilst working on developed ideas and brainstorming for decorative techniques and final design.
- Provide technical support to teaching staff and classes in all technology areas, adopting a flexible role to tackle a range of duties within the department
- Safely operate and maintain tools, equipment and materials as necessary
- Safely operate and maintain workshop equipment, machine and hand tools
- Prepare materials and teaching aids used in the department, including photocopying etc
- Work along side teachers during practical lessons to aid pupil progress
- Prepare worksheets for pupil use. Reprographic responsibilities for the Technology Department
- Make pieces of equipment, e.g. jigs, racks, etc
- Carry out routine checks and keep records of the departments stock. Ordering of stock as required, including sourcing appropriate equipment/ resources
